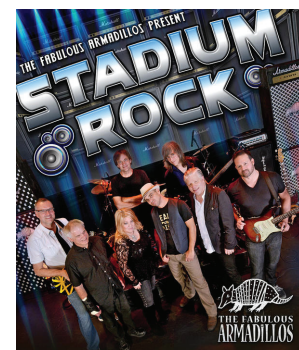

County Road 50 (Kenwood Trail) Closing on Monday, July 10

County Road 50 (Kenwood Trail) from County Road 60 (185th Street) to County Road 9 (Dodd Boulevard) will be reconstructed to increase capacity and improve safety. Dakota County is the lead agency for this project.

Beginning on Monday, July 10, CR50 will close between Dodd Boulevard and Icenic Trail and remain closed through mid-November. Additional road closures will include the remainder of CR50 from Dodd to

Ipava Avenue, slated to begin in September. A regional detour of 185th & Dodd will be in place, though local traffic may utilize additional routes of access. See lakevillemn.gov for maps and details.

THRIVE! BUSINESS UPDATES

The City of Lakeville hired **Kati Bachmayer** in June to fill the role of Economic Development Specialist. Bachmayer hails from Aberdeen, South Dakota and has a background in economic and workforce development, community outreach and constituent services. She looks forward to getting to know the Lakeville business community.

On June 19, the City Council approved a conditional use permit for **Bass Flexible Packaging Inc.** to expand their building and parking lot in the Airlake Industrial Park Second Addition (located between Heywood and Hemlock Avenues). The company specializes in printed and plain polypropylene bags and PVC shrinkable materials including shrink bands, bags, and roll stock. The new addition will add 7,058 square feet to the building, bringing the total size to 13,898 square feet.

The City Council also approved a conditional use permit for **Hypointe Childcare** to open at 8755 Upper 208th Street in the ISD 194 Community Education building downtown. Co-founders Tricia DeMarais and Jennifer Orth have a combined 24 years of experience in childcare and plan to provide full time, school-age, and flexible scheduled childcare to children aged 6 weeks to 12 years old. Opening in August 2017, the hours of operation will be Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.
