Items accepted include holiday lights, electric cords, telephone cords and appliance cords. Items not accepted include cord adapters, battery packs, plastic rope lights and CFL lights.

Lakeville's winter parking ordinance is in effect. No cars can be parked on the street between 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. even if it isn't snowing. There is also no on-street parking when it's snowing, until the roads have been cleared.
