Now There are New, Convenient Ways to Pay Your Utility Bill

The City of Lakeville has implemented a new online utility billing and payment system. Now there are three new convenient and secure ways to pay your utility bill with no convenience fees!

1. Register for online billing and payments with Payment Service Network (PSN), our secure online provider.
2. Pay on a mobile device by downloading the PSN Payments app.
3. Call PSN at 877-885-7968 to pay your bill by phone.

As part of the implementation of this new system, customers previously registered for automatic payments (ACH) or e-bills were removed and must create a new account to re-register for these options. You will continue to receive a paper statement until you register on the new system and opt in for e-bills.

Even if you prefer to receive paper bills, you can still pay your bill electronically with this new service.
