Practice Safe Excavation—Call Gopher State One Call Before You Dig

Starting a construction project? Planting trees, shrubs or a garden? Whether you're a professional excavator or homeowner using machine-powered equipment or just a shovel and rake, Minnesota state law requires you to contact Gopher State One Call (GSOC) before starting any excavation project. Doing so will reduce the risk of costly damages to underground utilities.

Here is the process for safe excavation:

- Contact GSOC at 811 at least 48 hours prior to the start of excavation (excluding holidays and weekends)

or submit a request online at gopherstateonecall.org.

- GSOC processes and submits your request to utility providers.
- Utility providers will mark the excavation site or advise if they are clear of utility-owned infrastructure. Refer to the graphic for colors of flag markers you may see on your site.

- The excavator must separately identify the location of any customer-owned lines (such as electricity for outbuildings, invisible fences, septic systems, satellite dishes), which are not marked with a call to GSOC.

Citywide Garage Sale is Saturday, May 19

The City of Lakeville is organizing a Citywide Garage Sale on Saturday, May 19 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Lakeville residents can submit the address of their garage sale to be included on a map of garage sale locations.

In order to participate in the Citywide Garage Sale and have your location listed on the map, we require the information in the online form for verification purposes. Only your address and items available will be included on the map.

A preliminary map of garage sales will be posted starting on Tuesday, May 1 and will be updated periodically through Wednesday,

May 16, as registrations are received. Registrations received after May 16 and addresses falling outside the borders of the City of Lakeville will not appear on the map. Register your sale online at lakevillemn.gov.



STAFF UPDATES

Public Works

Construction is expected to begin on Kenwood Trail/County Road 50 on April 16. Initial work includes grading and private utility relocation. The road will be closed from 185th Street to Jaguar Avenue. Detour signage will be posted in the field on April 2.

The Utilities Division completed 226 Gopher State One Call locates so far in March and has completed 236 water meter replacements in 2018.

Lakeville Heritage Center

Parks & Recreation

We were recently informed by the Minnesota Recreation and Parks Association (MRPA) that we were selected as a MRPA Award of Excellence recipient for the West Lake Marion Mountain Bike Trail project. This was a joint project between our Parks & Recreation Department and the Lakeville Cycling Association.

The restroom upgrade at Aronson Park is progressing. The contractor has completed all electrical and plumbing rough-in work. The ceiling and wall finishes are the next items to be completed.
